Multiple Measurement Rating (MMR) and Focus Rating (FR)

➤ **MMR and FR replace AYP**

- MMR is Minnesota's measurement for accountability, recognition and support
- All schools receive both an MMR and FR but there is not a district-level rating.
- Schools that receive Title 1 funds are eligible for one of five school designations

Multiple Measurement Rating (MMR) Overview

- **Multiple Measures of student success**
 - MMR rates schools in four categories: Proficiency, Growth, Achievement Gap Reduction, and Graduation Rate.
 - Each category is worth 25 points.
 - Elementary and Middle Schools can earn a total of 75 points while high schools can earn a total of 100 points.
- **MMR is a percent of points earned out of the total possible points.**

Focus Rating (FR) Overview

➤ Focus on Closing the Achievement Gap

- FR rates schools in two categories: Focused Proficiency and Achievement Gap Reduction.
- Focused Proficiency is based on proficiency goals for seven demographic groups: American Indian, Asian, Hispanic, Black, FRL, LEP, Special Education
- Demographic groups with less than 20 students are not considered
- Achievement Gap Reduction category is the same for MMR.
- Each category is worth 25 points.

Recognition and Support

Reward, Celebration, Continuous Improvement, Focus and Priority

- MDE's five levels of recognition and support based on MMR and Focus Rating – Title 1 schools only
 - **Reward School:** Top 15% of Title 1 schools
 - **Celebration Eligible:** Top 40% to 15% of Title 1 schools
 - **Continuous Improvement:** Bottom 25% of Title 1 schools
 - **Focus:** Bottom 10% of Title 1 schools based on FR only
 - **Priority:** Lowest performing 5% of Title 1 schools based on MMR

Recognition and Support

White Bear Lake Title 1 Schools

- White Bear Lake currently has four Title 1 schools: Birch Lake, Lakeaires, Vadnais, and Willow
 - **Reward School:** Willow
 - **Celebration Eligible:** Birch and Vadnais



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
