White Bear Lake Area Preschool offers school-year long classes. The program includes:

Early Childhood Special Education

Special Education services are provided free of charge to children birth to age five. Children younger than three are generally seen at home by teachers and specialists. Services for children 3-5 years old may include:

- · Integrated classroom opportunities
- Speech/Language, Occupational and Physical Therapy
- Home visits/community resource information
- Multi-disciplinary educational assessments

Toileting Skills

Three-year-olds

Children should be mostly bathroom independent, knowing when they need to use the bathroom, and are having few accidents.

Four-year-olds

Children need to be completely toilet trained.

Full Day Preschool - Mon-Fri

Age 4 by Sept 1, 2022

This full day, year-before-kindergarten program is designed to help children prepare to enter kindergarten with the skills and behaviors necessary to be successful. Children who are four years old on or before September 1 of the current school year and are toilet trained are eligible to enroll.

Children work on listening, personal and social development, language and literacy, thinking and math skills through guided play, group time, and social interaction. Activities include language arts, math, science, art, large muscle (gym/outside), dramatic play, blocks, and music.

Extended Day

Families who are registered for full day preschool can register for Extended Day at elementary school sites. Registration for 2022-2023 opens April 1 on a first come, first serve basis. Transportation options may be available for full day preschool students who attend full day preschool at their home elementary school. The transportation department will determine if you qualify.



School Readiness Plus -4 year old Preschool

Age 4 by Sept 1, 2022

This is a year-before-kindergarten preschool option for students who live within the Birch Lake, Willow Lane, or Vadnais Heights Elementary school boundaries. In order to enroll in this preschool at a reduced rate, a student must meet one of the following eligibility requirements:

- Homeless
- Foster Care
- English Language Learner
- At-risk Early Childhood Screening score
- Income

If your student does not meet any of these criteria, your child(ren) is still eligible to attend for a fee. The cost will be based on our School Readiness Plus sliding fee scale. For more information or to register call 651-653-3100.

Class Fees

Tamarack Nature Preschool fees are higher to cover the costs of a Ramsey County Naturalist. There is an additional one time non-refundable fee of \$100.00 for out of district residents attending Tamarack Nature Center Preschool.

How To Register for Preschool

To register for preschool, visit the White Bear Lake Area Schools Community Services & Recreation registration website at **whitebear.ce.eleyo.com**. A confirmation email will be sent when your student has been placed in their class and your payment account will be charged.

Early Childhood Screening

Screen at Three

Early Childhood Screening is required by the state of Minnesota for all children prior to entering kindergarten. White Bear Lake Area School District provides this screening at no charge.

3 reasons to screen at age 3

- Screening can help ensure school success
- If health or developmental concerns are identified, educational services are readily available
- It is fun for children and provides caregivers with valuable information regarding child development

Screening Procedure

Screening is being done in a one-on-one format. We suggest one parent accompany the child and no siblings at screening appointments.

- Plexiglass screens and masks are used by screening staff.
- All materials are cleaned in between appointments.
- Masks are required for adults and children.
