

At the June 27, 2019 Work-Study Meeting of the White Bear Lake Area School Board, the following items were presented and discussed:

1. Review of Facilities Plan. At its June 10 regular meeting, the School Board authorized district administration to develop parameters for a bond referendum to be discussed at the June 27 work-study meeting and acted upon at the July 15 regular School Board meeting. At the June 27 work-study meeting, an overview of the facilities plan was provided for the School Board. Included in the presentation was information related to the financing of the project and tax impact, proposed ballot language, the anticipated phasing of the project, and the Review and Comment Submittal which will be submitted to the Minnesota Department of Education following the July 15 meeting. The team that supported the facilities planning process attended the work-study session. Participants included Paul Aplikowski and Sal Bagley from Wold Architects and Engineers, John Huenink and Jason Peterson from Kraus-Anderson Construction, and Barbie Doyle and Shelby McQuay from Ehlers, Inc.
