

## White Bear Lake Area Schools School Board Meeting Highlights March 22, 2021 Work Session Meeting

At the March 22, 2021 Work Session Meeting of the School Board, the following items were discussed:

1. Overview of School Boundary Adjustment Process. Dennis Cheesebrow and Ray Queener from Teamworks International shared the process for studying and developing recommendations for new attendance boundaries for all elementary and middle schools to go into effect during the 2022-2023 school year, based on enrollment projections and subsequent capacity additions.
