At the October 22, 2018 Work-Study Meeting of the White Bear Lake Area School Board, the following items were presented and discussed:

1. <u>District Health Insurance</u>. Assistant Superintendent for Finance and Operations Tim Wald provided a review and update on the work of the District Insurance Committee. Pierre Guilfoile from National Insurance Services (NIS) presented the proposals from the recent RFP for health insurance administrative services.
