

White Bear Lake Area Schools School Board Meeting Highlights August 27, 2018 Work-Study Meeting

At the August 27, 2018 School Board Special Meeting of the White Bear Lake Area School Board, the following items were presented and discussed:

1. <u>TeamWorks Enrollment Report</u>. Assistant Superintendent for Finance and Operations Tim Wald and Teamworks International Founder Dennis Cheesebrow presented information related to the ten-year enrollment projection. This study is a complement to the demographic report completed by Hazel Reinhardt Consulting in the spring of 2017.

- 2. Comprehensive Facilities Planning, Community Engagement Overview. Assistant Superintendent for Finance and Operations Tim Wald and Wold Architects and Engineers Associate Sal Bagley presented information related to the district's Comprehensive Facilities Planning process, including a review of the charge statement for three committees that will be formed to study the needs of the district and recommend a long-range facilities master plan. The timeline of the process was discussed as well: potential board approval at Sept. 10 board meeting, application period from Sept. 11 to Sept. 24, first committee meeting on Oct. 9, committees report back to the board in January of 2019, facilities planning team members reconvene during Feb-March 2019 to review the outcomes of the needs study and develop a long-range facilities master plan for recommendation to the Board in spring 2019. - 3. <u>Strategic Priorities for 2018-19 School Year</u>. Superintendent Wayne Kazmierczak presented the School Board/District Administration Priorities for 2018-19 school year. The priorities are consistent with the Phase I Strategic Plan priorities that were discussed at the April 9, 2018 School Board meeting. Priority will be given to the following: 1) Comprehensive facilities planning process; 2) Elementary specialist program review; 3) Middle school program review; and 4) Completion of site level plans that align with the District's Strategic Plan. - 4. <u>Gifted and Talented Program Overview</u>. Assistant Superintendent for Teaching and Learning Sara Paul and our new Gifted and Talented / Student Agency Coordinator David Lamwers provided an overview of the program in the context of the new strategic plan.
