At the December 14, 2020 Regular Meeting of the School Board, the following items were presented and discussed:

1. <u>2021-22 School Year Calendar</u>. Assistant Superintendent for Teaching and Learning Dr. Alison Gillespie presented the 2021-22 calendar for discussion. The 2022-2023 calendar will be presented for discussion within the next couple months as construction timelines and project staging are being finalized.

- 4. <u>Presentation and Public Hearing Related to the Proposed 2020 Payable 2021 Property Tax</u> <u>Levy</u>. Assistant Superintendent for Finance and Operations Tim Wald and Controller Andi Johnson presented slides used to discuss the School District's 2020 payable 2021 property tax levy. Minnesota school districts are required to discuss the levy at a regularly scheduled School Board meeting and allow the public to speak.

- 3. <u>Action on Guaranteed Energy Saving Agreement</u>. The School Board approved the guaranteed energy savings contract with Ideal Energies, LLC and Green2 Solar Leasing, LLC for installing the second phase solar projects.
- 4. <u>Action on the Acceptance of Brosious Grants</u>. The School Board accepted six Brosious Teaching Grants from the White Bear Lake Area Educational Foundation as shown in the attached materials in the total amount of \$8,471.95.
- 5. <u>Action on Approval of 2021 Election Polling Locations</u>. The School Board approved the recommendation of the polling places for the 2021 State Primary and General Elections.
- Action on Approval of Additional Funds to MDE Expanded Meal Access Grant and the Ramsey County Emergency Food Services Grant. The School Board approved acceptance of the additional funding from the MDE Expanded Meal Access grant totaling \$20,000 and the Ramsey County Emergency Food Services Grant totaling \$376,572.58 for a combined total of \$396,572.58.
