

White Bear Lake Area Schools School Board Meeting Highlights May 14, 2018 Regular Meeting

Before the May 14 School Board meeting, students were recognized for state-level and nationallevel honors in the DARE poster contest, History Day, and state honor middle school orchestra, band and choir.

At the May 14, 2018 Regular Meeting, the following items were presented and discussed:

- 1. <u>Recognize Student Liaisons to the School Board</u>. The White Bear Lake Area School Board recognized Ashley Rensted, 12th grade student, and Makena Pratt, 11th grade student, for their outstanding role as the 2017-18 Student Representatives on the School Board. Additionally, Rensted was presented with a Student School Board Member Scholarship from the Minnesota School Boards Association.
- 2. <u>White Bear Lake Area Schools Career Pathways Update</u>. A district team of Assistant Superintendent for Teaching and Learning Sara Paul, South Campus Principal Don Bosch, North Campus Principal Alison Gillespie, Teaching and Learning Coordinator Jill Pearson, and Career Navigators Jeremy Kerg and Jennifer Moore provided an update on the district's Career Pathways work. In addition, students shared their success stories of how their involvement in career pathways has accelerated them into college and career opportunities.
