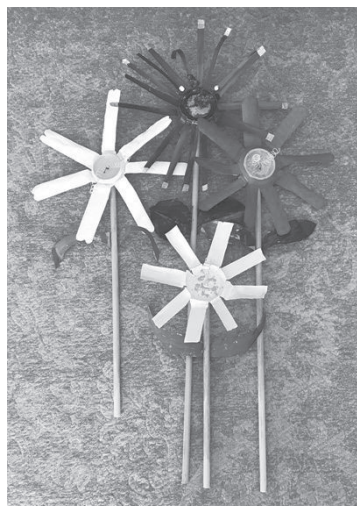

Crystal Cave Tour and Gem Sluicing
