At the October 9, 2017 School Board Regular meeting of the White Bear Lake Area School Board, the following items were presented and discussed:

1. <u>Strategic Planning Update</u>. Dr. Kazmierczak and Angela Nelson, association principal at North Campus, provided an update on the Strategic Planning Team meeting that took place in September. The following agenda items were acted upon:

1. <u>Action on Resolution to Ratify the Award of the Sale of Bonds</u>. The School Board approved the Resolution Ratifying the Award of the Sale, Determining the Form and Details, Authorizing the Execution, Delivery, and Registration, and Providing for the Payment of General Obligation Alternative Facilities Refunding Bonds, Series 2017A as presented.

- 2. Action on Resolution for Combined Primary Polling Place for 2018 State Primary and State General Election. The School Board approved the resolution and combined the three polling places (P1, P4, and P6) in the Lino Lakes area for the 2018 State primary and State general election.
- 3. <u>Action on Grant from Greater White Bear Lake Community Foundation</u>. The School Board approved the \$1,800 grant from the Greater White Bear Lake Community Foundation to Willow Lane Elementary for READ5000.
