

White Bear Lake Area Schools School Board Meeting Highlights April 10, 2017 Regular Meeting

Before the April 10, 2017 Regular Meeting of the White Bear Lake Area School Board, the School Board recognized students who received state-level honors in the following activities: Wrestling Team Members, Swim Team Member, Girls Basketball Team, and Unified Bears, Basketball Team, and Central Middle School Art Students.

At the April 10, 2017 Regular Meeting of the White Bear Lake Area School Board, the following agenda items were presented and discussed:

- 1. <u>State-Level Teacher and Administrator Recognitions</u>. The School Board honored two district staff members who have received state-level awards: Teacher/Coach Patti Percival, who received the Breaking Barriers Award, and Activities Director Tim Hermann, who received the Region 4AA Athletic Administrator of the Year and the Minnesota Athletic Administrators Association's 2017 "Pete Veldman AA Athletic Administrator of the Year."
- 2. <u>Update on Partnership with Hangzhou Foreign Language Schools</u>. The School Board heard briefly from Ting Ting Zhou, this year's exchange teacher from Hangzhou Foreign Languages School, who has been with us since September. The District began a partnership with Hangzhou Foreign Languages School in 2010, with Chinese students serving residencies in White Bear Lake Area Schools and district teachers traveling to Hangzhou to teach in China for full semesters.
